Easter Egg Hunt


73 Years—Southeast Lions Easter Egg Hunt

Dear Friends and Family,

I am super excited to report that SVOSH has returned from another successful mission to bring sight to those less fortunate. This year we were blessed to be able to travel to Maryville, TN with10 students and 2 doctors toprovide care to 231 patients. None of this would have been possible without the continued prayers and monetary support that you donate, and for that we are all eternally thankful. This was the first trip SVOSH was able to serve since the COVID-19 pandemic began, so although things looked a little different than usual, it was still overall a successful mission.





We worked closely with Remote Area Medical (RAM) to provide the vision care screenings, and with their help we were also able to work alongside dentists and primary care doctors who provided dental and medical care. Our president, Ellen Smith, shared a story of a patient staying the night in their car in the parking lot the night before our clinic just to get her eyes checked. The patient was so grateful to not only receive that care, but also receive their first pair of glasses in a long time. Ellen said that it allowed her to under-

stand the health care disparities in our country in a new light.

During the trip we saw many interesting cases and conditions including diabetic retinopathy, cataracts, glaucoma, and various retinal hemorrhages. After patients were seen by us, they would go and pick out a new pair of glasses free of charge to take home with them that day. One little girl that I did prescreening tests on was so excited to pick out a new pair of glasses because her current pair were missing a temple on one side and had been taped up on the other. When I saw her in the hallway later on that afternoon she said that she couldn't



remember what it was like to not have to hold one side of her glasses up so that they didn't fall off.



After two long and rewarding days of clinic, SVOSH kicked back to relax and enjoy the beauty Tennessee had to offer.* We went ziplining through the Smoky Mountains, explored downtown Gatlinburg, and were able to listen to a local band at dinner one night. Being able to share stories of the clinic and laugh about the memories made was worth all the time we put into the days at the clinic.

This trip was extremely successful as a direct result of your generous contribu-

tions. We truly made a difference in our patient's lives, and

they most certainly have touched ours for eternity.

Thank you for giving all of us the opportunity to give the gift of sight to others around us.

LiFEsports is a sport-based positive youth development program operated by The Ohio State University. LiFEsports promotes leadership and life skills through sport within their summer camp. year round clinics, and Youth they serve over 500 youth from socially vulnerable circumstances across 44 zip codes in Central Ohio! LiFEsports operates programs on campus, as well as in two community-based sites at the Beatty and Linden Community Centers. LiFEsports is more than sports. They teach valuable social skills (Self-Control, Effort, Teamwork, and Social Responsibility; SETS) kids need to be successful on and off the field!

Jermaine has been involved in LiFEsports since he we 9 years old. Here's what he says about his LiFEsports experience:

"The role and thing that LiFEsports taught me is that there is more than one way to do things. I learned to improvise, be flexible, stay calm, and be level-headed under stress when I was a kid and then when I was managing kids because those two aren't that different. I learned you have to account for your own thoughts. I also see a lot that carried

over in terms of being flexible. I had a bump in the road with school and took a break and then I got back to it as soon as I could. I also learned about non-verbal relations...like not every kid is not good with words, but I will say the other 85% is nonverbal Leadership Academy. Each year and that is how I came to understand them better. Kids might not always say what you want them to, but you can see a shrug or them digging in their heels or a frown and I learned a lot being around children that applies so much to adults."

> Jermaine continues to volunteer at LiFEsports clinics and events while attending school and working at Amazon. He is a pillar of the program and remains in touch with program staff and the friends he made at LiFEsports.

> Coach Sam, a former YLA program manager said of Jermaine, "He always wanted to work with the little kids and had the patience to make them feel seen, valued, and heard. Over the years, I watched him evolve into a leader within the program leading his peers and the younger youth in the program. I have no doubt he will be an incredible doctor and advocate for children in the future."

MEMBERSHIP TYPES AND FEES

New Member

New members pay an entrance fee of US\$35 or must submit the proper waiver certification form. International dues total US \$43 annually. Dues are billed on a semiannual basis. Additional district, multiple district and club dues may apply.

Transfer Member

Transfer members in good standing pay no entrance fee when transferring to an existing club within 12 months.

Family Member

The Family Membership Program

provides families with the opportunity to receive a special dues discount when they join a Lions club together. The first family member (head of household) pays full international dues (US\$43), and up to four additional family members pay only half the international dues (US\$21.50). All family members pay the one-time entrance fee of US\$35. The Family Membership Program is open to family members who are (1) eligible for Lions membership, (2) currently in or joining the same club, and (3) living in the same household and related by birth, marriage or other legal relationship. Common household family members include parents, children, spouses, aunts and uncles, cousins, grandparents, in-laws and legal dependents. Submit the Family Unit Certification Form (TK-30).

Student

Students between the age of majority and through age 30 pay no entrance fee and half international dues. Students over age 30 and joining a Campus Lions club pay a US\$10 entrance fee and full international dues. Submit the Student Member Certification Form (STU-5) for each student.

Current or Former Leo

All graduating Leos receive an

entrance fee waiver. Current or former Leos, through the age of 30, who have been a Leo for at least a year and a day,pay half international dues. Submit the Leo to Lion Certification and Years of Service Transfer Form (LL-2) for each current or former Leo under 30.

Young Adult

Young adults, through the age of 30, receive an entrance fee waiver and pay half international dues when joining a Leo Lions club. Submit the Leo to Lion Certification and Years of Service Transfer Form (LL-2) for each young adult.
