If you had the pleasure of having a beer with Stretch, you undoubtedly heard him beaming with pride about his South End roots. His great grandparents immigrated to the area from Germany in the early 1900's. He went to St Mary's Grade School and was part of the Wehrle High School Class of 1970. He loved being a South Ender, from his days growing up in a tiny house on Lear St to his high school years and beyond on Moler. He lived at the affectionately-dubbed "Gates Manor" just out of college, a house that was infamous for a lot of things that are not appropriate to print. And, the first home he owned was bought from his grandmother on Frebis Ave. His dad was a regular at the Sycamore back in its heyday and Stretch continued that tradition with Sunday Euchre until the bar closed.

One of his first jobs was at Papa Joe's but his claim-to-fame was as the first taste tester at the original Donatos Pizza, which made him a fan for life. He would have had Donatos for every meal if he could and he knew every Pickerington delivery guy by name, especially the one that found Ashley's cat under the garage door.

After moving away from the South End to raise his kids in the burbs, he never missed an opportunity to return to the neighborhood. His favorite bar was The Beck, just as much for special occasions as for the average happy hour. The annual visit from Woody Hayes at the Beck was enjoyed by everyone, including his grandsons. He loved stopping into Plank's Garten, Plank's Cafe, or a St Mary's festival to see family and friends. He spent most of the 80's and 90's at Greenlawn (now Berliner) and made some of his lifelong friends on the ball diamond and basketball court.

Stretch and Kathleen frequented the German Village yard sale and made it a point to stop in the Hey Hey every St Patrick's Day. Many Mother Mohawks and Bahama Mamas were enjoyed during his "business lunches" with coworkers, plumbers, his kids, Kathleen, or a combination of all of the above. He loved being with people and was at his best while holding court with a Budweiser in one hand and telling some outrageous story with the other. No one embodied one of his favorite Jack Ponsler quotes more than Stretch - "Don't confuse the issue with the facts".

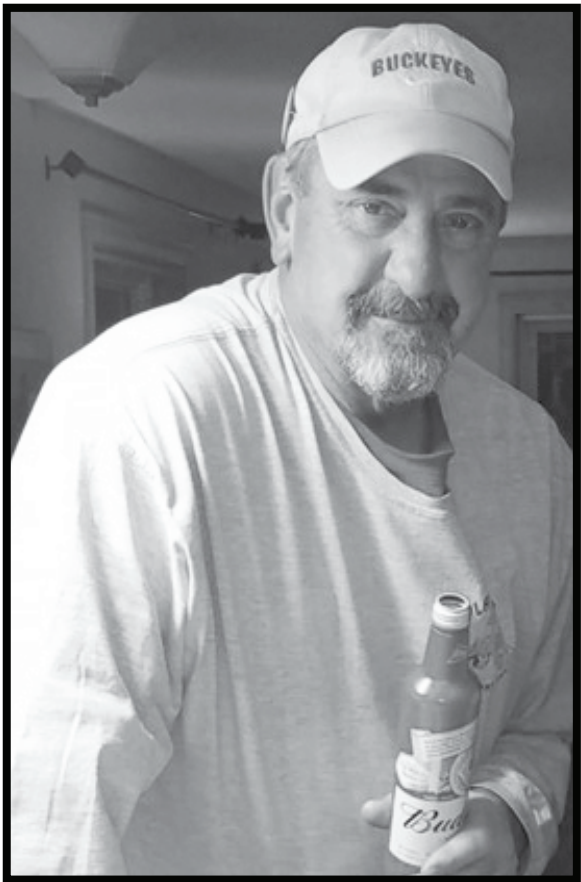
He was a professional bullshitter. So much so that he was the self-proclaimed Best Shitter Salesman in Columbus for 35 years

in a row. Stretch was loved by many, but Kathleen may be the only person who ever loved him more than he loved himself.

He was loyal to a fault, a friend to many, and a jack-of-all-trades around the house. If he didn't know how to do it, he knew someone who did. The amount of water heaters he installed around Ohio would rival some of his longtime plumbing customers and he never asked for anything in return, which everyone understood meant a case of Bud.

Stretch was taken from us far too soon, but we are certain he was thankful to be aware during his final months so he could enjoy the continuous stream of visitors. For once, he had to sit back and listen to other people talk, which we all know was difficult for him. And true to his roots, his last drink was a Bud surrounded by the people that mean the most to him.

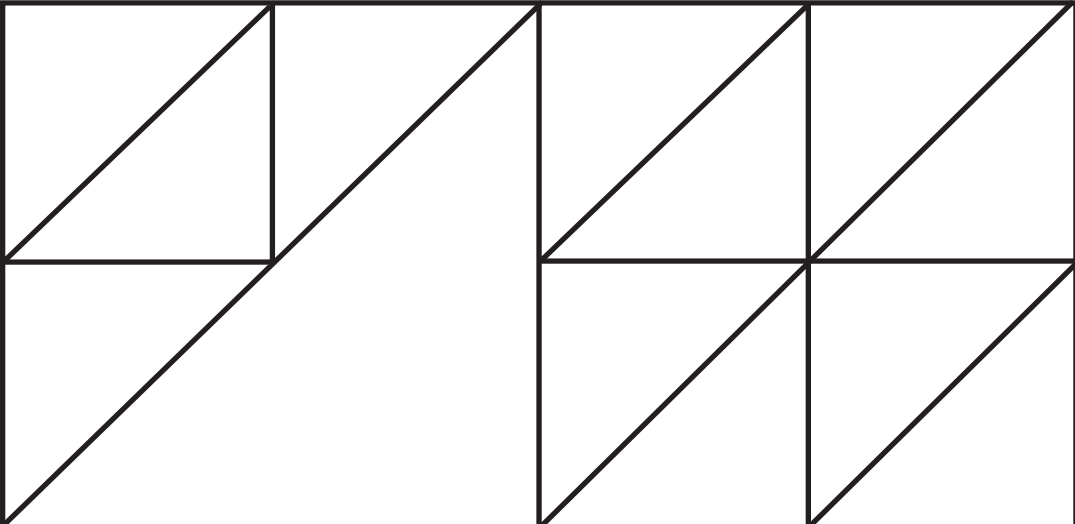

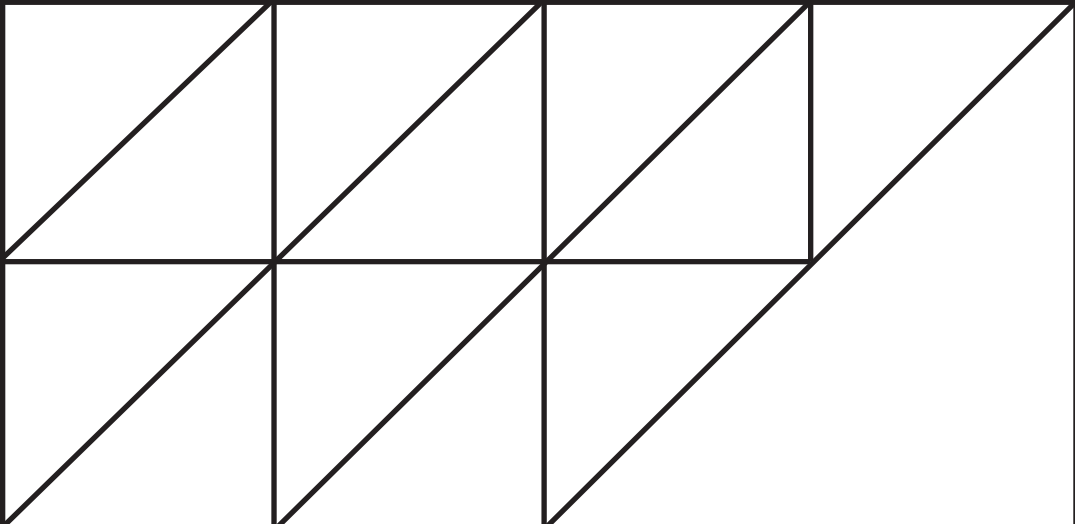

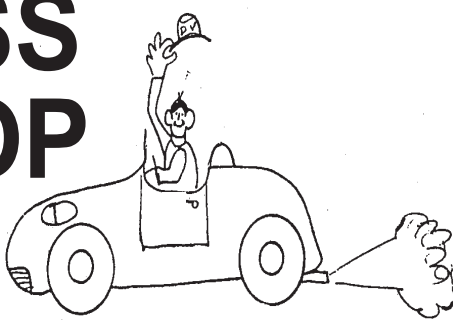

# LiFEsports

The LiFEsports Initiative was proud to be back in full force this summer for the first time since the COVID-19 pandemic. Thanks to our ongoing donors, like the Southeast Lions, we were able to expand our reach in 2022. In total nearly 700 youth were served in our summer camp programs! 75% of all youth served were living at or below 200% of the poverty line.

Specifically, LiFEsports served youth in six different summer camps, our traditional four-week at Ohio State main campus, three, eight-week camps in partnership with Columbus Recreation and Parks, and two, four-week camps in partnership with Dublin City Schools. As always all our summer camp programs focused on teaching social skills (self-control, effort, teamwork, and social responsibility – S.E.T.S.) through sport. Our youth reported great



outcomes from their participation in camp, including being able to control their feelings better, learning to act responsibly while playing sports, and using S.E.T.S. in their school, home and community.

In addition to new camp locations this year, our main campus program also added a bus pick-up and drop-off location at Schiller Park to better serve youth within the Southeast Lions’ service area.

LiFEsports is hopeful that with additional marketing in the neighborhood, we can reach our goal of serving 50 youth from the Southeast annually. 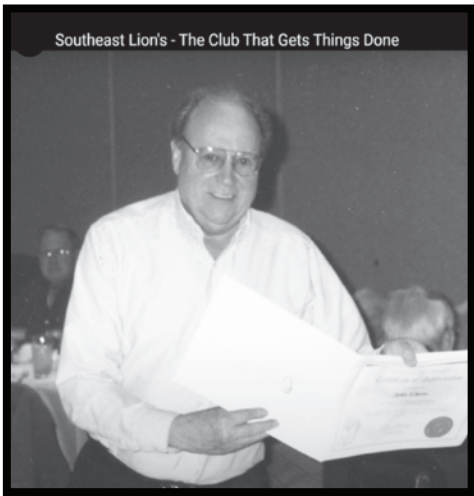

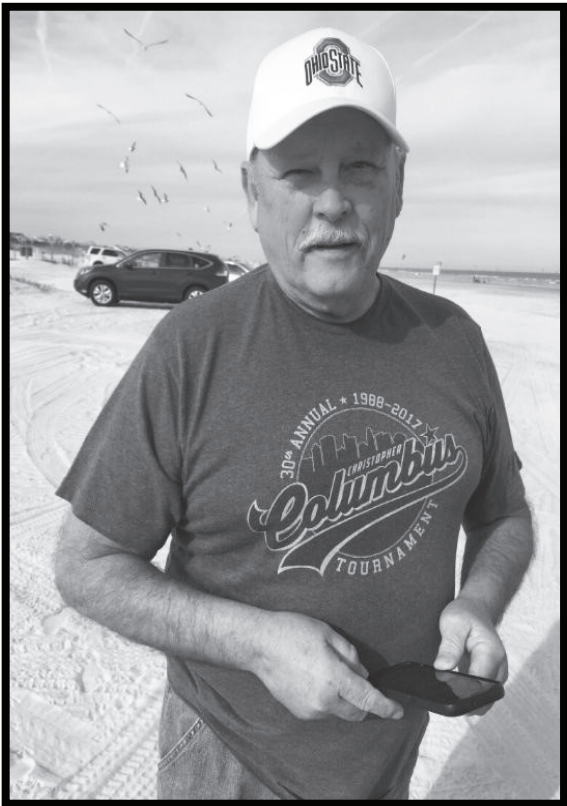

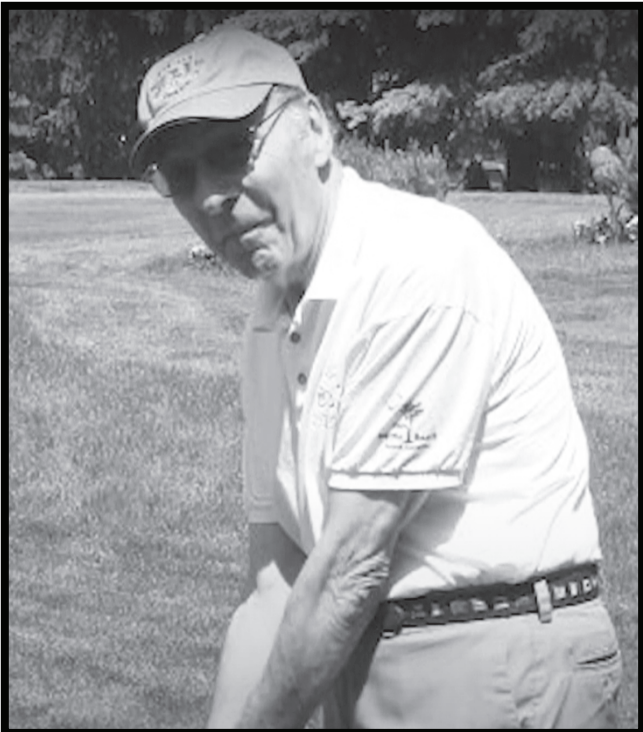

# Southside Parks and Programs

## A Long Tradition of Lions Support for Parks and Youth

It started in 1946 when the Southeast Lions Club purchased, and donated the land on Barthman and S. Sixth St to the City of Columbus for use as a park and playground for their Southside neighbors. The SE Lions also included a check for \$700 for equipment. Southeast Lions Park has faced many challenges recently, but this 76-year-old park remains a wonderful green space for neighbors and children to enjoy to this day.

The Southeast Lions are also part of the history of Southwood-Mileusnich Park. Originally named Southwood Park, this was the longtime site for YMCA baseball and then Schiller/AASC/Lions' baseball. Lion Mike Mileusnich, loved the southside and supported many groups and organizations in the community. Mike was SE Lion president in 1967 and again in 1986 and he served as president of the Council of Southside organizations. As baseball umpire, Mike was inducted into the Ohio High School Hall of Fame for officials after retiring. Mike's devotion to the youth of the southside inspired the city to rename Southwood Park to Southwood-Mileusnich Park in

Mike's honor. After the rebuilding of Southwood Elementary it still has two active ball diamonds on the property.



Another park with Southeast Lions history is SILLS park, for years a mecca for baseball on the southside of Columbus. After baseball began to decline in popularity the park became overgrown and unused. In 1989, Lion Richard Sammons, a long-time member of the Southeast Lions and president in 1993-1994, approached the group about using it for his AASC baseball organization, which had outgrown Southwood Park. CSX Railroad owned the property, but had it up for sale. The City of Columbus was convinced and purchased the park in 1998 so children would continue to have a safe place to play baseball.

Lion Rich Sammons was restricted to a wheel chair but that never stopped him from

orchestrating the baseball, softball and t-ball programs at Sills Park. Lion Rich also saved the city thousands of dollars as he personally maintained the diamonds and cut the grass for years in the park he loved. After Lion Rich passed away a petition to rename the park in his honor was accepted by the Recreation and Parks Department. The park was renamed Richard Sammons Park in 2020, now known as Sammons Park. It continues to provide memories for families and their children for many generations to come.

The Southeast Lions provided support for other southside parks, including the playground and outdoor basketball court at Schiller Park, youth sports

scholarships for Schiller and Marion Franklin Community Centers as well as funding for baseball, basketball and soccer leagues for decades. LiFEsports, a youth development program operated by The Ohio State University is also co-sponsored by The Southeast Lions Club.

The Southeast Lions Club is proud of the parks, programs and lives we have been able to support.





# Parsons Elementary School Third Grade Walkie Talkie Program receives pedometers for 50 students.

In January 2022 a Facebook post about third graders at Parsons Elementary School walking program triggered a desire for the Southeast Lions to find a way to reward their initiative.

Casey Copper-Fent, then a third-grade teacher at Parsons Elementary: 'It is a meditation session 15 minutes each morning. We walk as a class for exercise and to prepare our mind for morning learning. We walk 10 miles per week, 2 miles per day. Students earn a "Brag Tag" for every ten miles walked. We walk the perimeter of the playground, chat with friends, and sometimes we have a guest walker from the community to come and chat with us as we walk. The community helper will talk about his or her job and the students may ask questions.

The kiddos love the program. It is something that we teachers made up during the beginning of the pandemic

when students had to stay in their seats and distance. We called it "The Walkie Talkie". It helps take the stress out of the day and the students are much more prepared for learning.'

In early March; Lions Tom Grote, Marc Borst and Ellen LePera presented the third graders with pedometers and copies of the 2021 Southeast Lions Roar newspaper. Most had never laid eyes on a newspaper before.

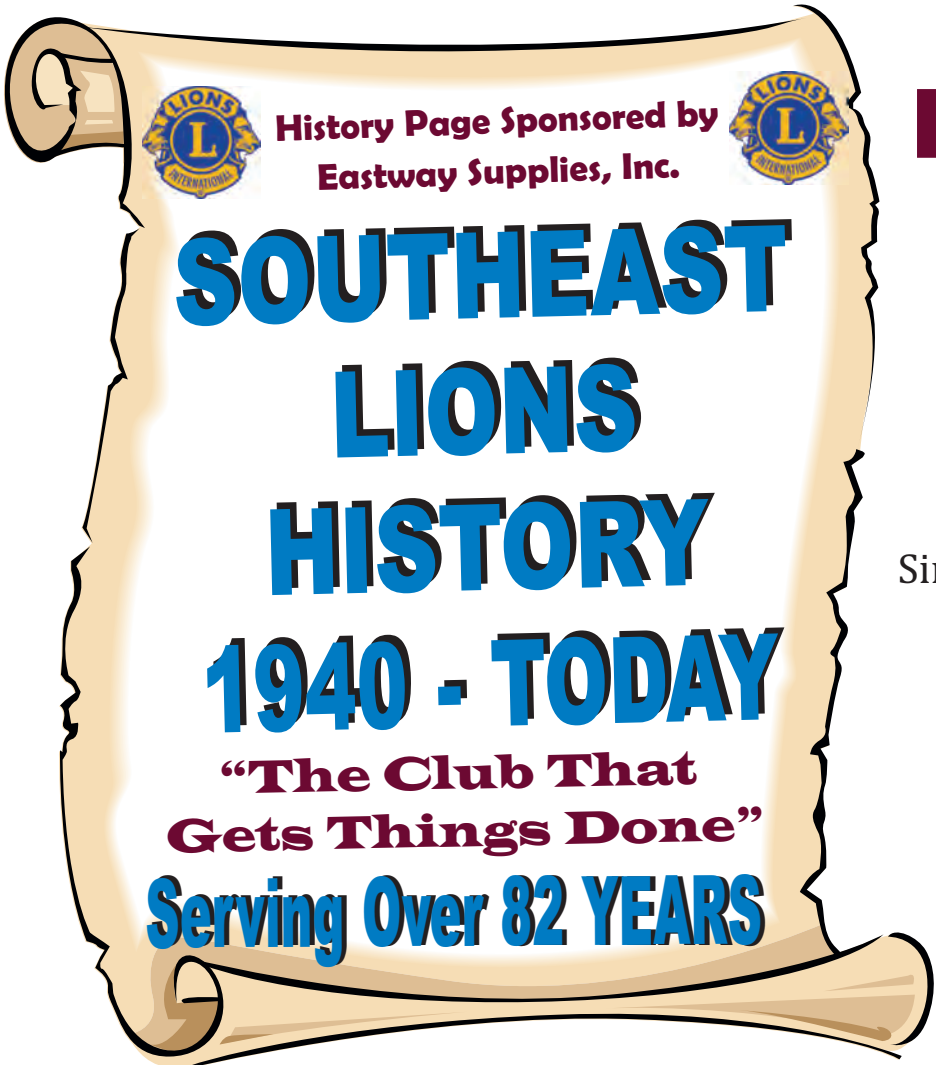
